# The Infinity Code

- 1) All Hebrew letters have a numeric value.
- 2) Therefore, if all Hebrew letters have numerical values, all Hebrew words must have numeric values as well.
- 3) Accordingly, if you take the value of the Hebrew word and go to that chapter in the bible, you will find one or more of the following:
  - a) The actual word in the text.
  - b) A synonym (or sometimes an antonym of the word in the text.
  - c) A discussion of the word or its concept in the text.

- 31 ¶ And thou shalt make a <u>candlestick</u> of pure gold: of beaten work shall the <u>candlestick</u> be made: his shaft, and his branches, his bowls, his knops, and his flowers, shall be of the same.
- 32 And six branches shall come out of the sides of it; three branches of the <u>candlestick</u> out of the one side, and three branches of the <u>candlestick</u> out of the other side: (1+3+3)
- 40 And look that thou make them after their <u>pattern</u>, which was shewed thee in the mount.



#### Revelation 1

- 4 John to the <u>seven churches</u> which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the <u>seven Spirits</u> which are before his throne;
- The mystery of the <u>seven stars</u> which thou sawest in my right hand, and the <u>seven golden candlesticks</u>. The <u>seven stars</u> are the <u>angels of the seven churches</u>: and the <u>seven candlesticks</u> which thou sawest are the <u>seven churches</u>.

# The Infinity Code

- 1. All Hebrew letters have a numeric value.
- 2. Therefore, if all Hebrew letters have numerical values, all Hebrew words must have numeric values as well.
- 3. Accordingly, if you take the value of the Hebrew word and go to that chapter in the bible, you will find one or more of the following:
  - a) The actual word in the text.
  - b) A synonym (or sometimes an antonym of the word in the text.
  - c) A discussion of the word or its concept in the text.
