

Potential Order of Events in the End-Times Bible Study

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Established Order of Events

1. The Jewish People (Generally, the tribes of Judah, Benjamin, and Levi, though others are included as well) Gathered in the Historical Land of Israel.
 - The Balfour Declaration (November 2, 1917) – The land of Israel Becomes a “homeland” for the Jewish People
 - Israel becomes a Nation-State on May 14, 1948
 - Israel Occupies All of Jerusalem After the Six-Day War completed on June 7, 1967
 - However, at the end of the Six-Day War, General Moshe Dayan allowed the Jordanians to control the Temple Mount.
 - In 1993, the Camp David Accords turned the Temple Mount over to the Palestinian Authority. Some say that he did this at the orders of Dean Rusk, U.S. Secretary of State.

Deuteronomy 30:3-5

That then the LORD thy God will turn thy captivity, and have compassion upon thee, and will return and gather thee from all the nations, whither the LORD thy God hath scattered thee. If any of thine be driven out unto the outmost parts of heaven, from thence will the LORD thy God gather thee, and from thence will he fetch thee: And the LORD thy God will bring thee into the land which thy fathers possessed, and thou shalt possess it; and he will do thee good, and multiply thee above thy fathers.

Isaiah 10:20-22

And it shall come to pass in that day, that the remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay upon him that smote them; but shall stay upon the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, in truth. The remnant shall return, even the remnant of Jacob, unto the mighty God. For though thy people Israel be as the sand of the sea, yet a remnant of them shall return: the consumption decreed shall overflow with righteousness.

Isaiah 11:11-12

And it shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from Pathros, and from Cush, and from Elam, and from Shinar, and from Hamath, and from the islands of the sea. And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

Isaiah 11:11-12: Location of Cities in Verse 12

- Assyria – Western Iraq
- Egypt – Egypt, Sudan
- Pathros – Northern Egypt
- Cush - Ethiopia
- Elam – Southern Persia (Susa)
- Shinar – Babylon, Central Iraq
- Hamath – Northeast Syria
- Islands of the Sea – Great Britain, USA (?)

Jeremiah 23:3

And I will gather the remnant of my flock out of all countries whither I have driven them, and will bring them again to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase.

Jeremiah 31:10

Hear the word of the LORD, O ye nations, and declare it in the isles afar off, and say, He that scattered Israel will gather him, and keep him, as a shepherd doth his flock.

Ezekiel 37:12

Therefore prophesy and say unto them,
Thus saith the Lord GOD;
Behold, O my people,
I will open your graves,
and cause you to come up out of your graves,
and bring you into the land of Israel.

Amos 9:14

And I will bring again the captivity
of my people of Israel,
and they shall build the waste cities,
and inhabit them;
and they shall plant vineyards,
and drink the wine thereof;
they shall also make gardens,
and eat the fruit of them.

Micah 5:3

Therefore will he give them up,
until the time that
she which travaileth hath brought forth:
then the remnant of his brethren
shall return unto the children of Israel.

Zephaniah 3:20

At that time will I bring you again,
even in the time that I gather you:
for I will make you a name and a
praise among all people of the earth,
when I turn back your captivity before your eyes,
saith the LORD.

Zechariah 8:6-8

And I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God, in truth and in righteousness.

Summary of Part I:

In all these scriptures, the Lord states:

- He will
 - bring,
 - gather,
 - assemble the remnant
- They will return to Israel!
- What mechanism, or how?
- He does not explain to us...
- We will only see how, as it unfolds.

Established Order of Events

2. The old desolate and waste cities are rebuilt and inhabited.

- It started when the Jews started returning to the land under the “British Mandate” after World War I, when General Allenby drove the Ottoman Turks out of the “Promised Land.” The Balfour Declaration permitted Jews to emigrate to Israel in mass numbers for the first time in centuries.
- When Israel became a nation in 1948, immigration increased considerably. The *Kibbutz* system established agriculture in Israel to the point they now export.
- West Bank settlements have increased since President Trump has taken office in the USA.
- The nation of Israel has yet to totally turn to the Lord as their God as described!



Isaiah 44:26

- That confirmeth the word of his servant,
- and performeth the counsel of his messengers;
- that saith to Jerusalem,
- Thou shalt be inhabited; and to the cities of Judah,
- Ye shall be built, and
- I will raise up the decayed places thereof...

Isaiah 54:3

- For thou shalt break forth
- on the right hand
- and on the left;
- and thy seed shall inherit the Gentiles, and
- make the desolate cities to be inhabited.

Isaiah 61:43

- And they shall build the old wastes,
- they shall raise up the former desolations,
- and they shall repair the waste cities,
- the desolations of many generations.

Jeremiah 33:12

Thus saith the LORD of hosts;

- Again in this place, which is desolate
 - without man and without beast, and
- in all the cities thereof,
- shall be an habitation of shepherds
- causing their flocks to lie down.

Ezekiel 36:10

And I will multiply men upon you,
all the house of Israel, even all of it:
and the cities shall be inhabited,
and the wastes shall be builded...

Ezekiel 36:33

Thus saith the Lord GOD;

In the day that I shall have cleansed you
from all your iniquities

I will also cause you to dwell in the cities,
and the wastes shall be builded.

Ezekiel 36:35

And they shall say,
This land that was desolate is become
like the garden of Eden; and
the waste and desolate and ruined cities
are become fenced, and are inhabited.

Amos 9:14

And I will bring again
the captivity of my people of Israel, and
they shall build the waste cities, and
inhabit them...

Established Order of Events

3. Israel Meets Resistance (Hatred) from Her Neighbors:
- Israeli War of Independence (November 1947 to July 1949)
 - Reprisal Operations (1950 – 1956)
 - 1956 Suez Crisis – The British and French aided Israel in trying to Internationalize the Suez Canal. They Invaded Egypt, but the United States and the Soviet Union (Russia) Insisted the War be Stopped.
 - Continued Reprisal Operations (1957- 1967)
 - Arab-Israeli Six-Day War (June 5, 1967 to June 10, 1967)
 - Yom Kipper War (October 6-26, 1973)
 - Lebanon Wars (1976, 1982, 2005)
 - Seven Military Operations Against Hezbollah and Hamas (1985-2014)

Psalms 25:19

Consider mine enemies;
for they are many;
and they hate me with cruel hatred.

Redeem Israel, O God,
